Dear Prospective Dance Ensemble Student and Parent,

We are very pleased that your son/daughter is considering auditioning for the 2021-2022 IHS Dance Ensemble. He/She will make new friends, enjoy using his/her dance talents in a unique way, and will also experience in a positive light the meaning of commitment and responsibility!

As a parent, you may not be the one in the limelight, but you are vital to the success of the team through your time and talents. This is a yearlong commitment, so please read the following responsibilities carefully BEFORE deciding if IHS Dance Ensemble is for you and your student. **If you are at all unsure of your ability to make the commitment, please do not audition.**

Be aware that this is NOT a "win at all costs" team. All members will strive for personal best but with the understanding that we all have different abilities, the most important being the willingness to make a **solid commitment to the Ensemble.**

MANDATORY FUNDRAISING PARTICIPATION OBLIGATIONS

- Jr. Dance Club Mondays in the fall. All team members are required to choreograph and teach Jr. Dance Club participants, money raised goes towards costumes and production fees.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

To maintain the integrity of the program, we are asking for a \$100 contribution per semester to help cover the costs of the following production costs: lighting designer, additional lighting rentals, guest artists/choreographers, judges, props, programs, tickets, advertisement, pictures, thematic decorations. The Dance Ensemble is self-sustaining. Contributions are a necessity for the existence of the program.

Ensemble Uniform:

The captains will choose team wear for the 2021-2022 year. Purchasing the clothing is optional; however, to show a cohesiveness in the team, if you choose not to purchase the team wear, you are expected to find clothing that is similar to the team wear.

You are welcome to purchase your own matching team agreed upon gear, or we will have the following items available for purchase:

\$235 (approx.) Team Wear (Jacket, sweats, shirts, shorts, performance wear)

\$15 Show Shirt (per semester)

You must provide your own shoes, tights, and undergarments

SUMMER DANCE CAMP attendance is strongly suggested for team development and continuity. Dates are **August 2-5 Cost is \$450 (Quad room—2 per bed)**. This includes food and lodging. This will be based on CDC and district recommendations. Otherwise, we will do an "At Home Camp" with the same dates.

MANDATORY TIME COMMITMENTS FOR PARENTS

- □ Provide transportation.
- Make sure your son/daughter is on time to all events. This may seem minor but is very important. Please do not schedule appointments for your son/daughter during practice times or class.
- □ <u>Willingly volunteer</u> your time and talents to help make this a successful year.
- □ Support the fundraisers, rehearsal schedule, and functions.

MANDATORY COMMITMENTS FOR DANCERS

- Place an emphasis on teamwork, BE ON TIME FOR REHEARSALS, follow dress code and be enthusiastic!
- □ Be attentive and focused at all rehearsals. No excessive talking.
- □ Respect Captains, fellow teammates, Director, guest choreographer and yourself!
- □ No attendance/academic/discipline problems with school. IHS Dance Ensemble has a zero tolerance policy towards drugs or alcohol. You may not perform if on Probation at IHS.
- Dancers will be responsible for continuing their dance training outside of class and rehearsals.
- □ See Director with problems or concerns.

MANDATORY REHEARSAL TIMES

- During Class and Monday afternoons. Outside dances and captains will have additional practice times.
- Occasional rehearsal times planned around schedules of guest choreographers.
- □ 4 hour cleaning rehearsals and extended hours during Cleaning/Show week.

These are not optional. All team members are required to attend all rehearsals.

If a dancer is unable to attend rehearsal due to illness/emergency, the parent must notify Mrs. Sloate via text or e-mail <u>sherylsloate@iusd.org</u> prior to rehearsal.

Please look over the enclosed checklist and review the commitments carefully before the audition. If your child is selected and decides not to continue as a Dance Ensemble Member, he/she will have taken a spot away from another student. We want you and your child to be comfortable with the commitment and hopefully you have been given the facts in order to make an informed and correct decision. **Most importantly: Please do not audition if you are not 100% committed to this program.**
