- evidence of registration to a two-year community college, trade, or technical school, due 10/1/2021

ITA Scholarship for Applicants to 4-year College and Universities Future Educators

Qualifications:

- <u>typed</u> formal application for scholarship consideration
- Irvine USD high school graduate, class of 2021
- evidence of registration to an accredited four-year college or university, due 10/1/2021
- evidence of interest in entering the education profession

Qualifications:

- <u>typed</u> formal application for scholarship consideration
- high school graduate, class of 2021
- evidence of registration to an accredited four-year college or university, due 10/1/2021
- child or dependent of a <u>current member</u> of the Irvine Teachers Association
