Scholarship Overview

The Bio-Rad Scholarship Program assists local graduating high school students who wish to pursue careers in science or engineering. The program provides financial assistance to deserving students so they can continue their pursuit of science and engineering in higher education. This program is available to children of QSD employees as well as any students attending Irvine Unified School District.

Applications are evaluated based on students' personal connection to science and engineering, as well as the originality, clarity, and persuasiveness of their answers to essay questions.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for a scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a graduating, college-bound senior from Irvine Unified School District in Irvine, CA.
 or a student whose parent is employed at QSD.
- Have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- Have already been accepted to a 2- or 4-year college at the time scholarships are awarded in May of each year
