23 campuses, one application

- Application Deadline October 1– November 30
  - SAT **OR**
  - ACT
  - SAT Subject Exams and writing are **not** required at this time
- **NO** Essays/Insight Questions
- **NO** Letters of Recommendation

# UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA (UC)

- 9 campuses, one application
- Application Window August 1 – November 30
  - SAT with writing **OR**
  - ACT with writing
  - **NOTE:** SAT Subject Exams are optional; however, **may be** required for particular majors
- Personal Insight Questions **Required**
- **NO** Letters of Recommendation

# CALIFORNIA PRIVATE COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES

- 84 campuses, one application for each campus or many colleges use the Common Application:  
[www.commonapp.org/](http://www.commonapp.org/)
- Not part of a “system” of colleges
- Testing requirements vary
- Application decisions and deadlines vary
- Cost is higher
- Letters of recommendation are generally required

# OUT-OF-STATE COLLEGES/ UNIVERSITIES



- Public and private colleges
- Admission requirements differ from campus to campus

# ACADEMIC ASSESSMENT TRANSCRIPTS AND GRAD STATUS



- Personal information
- Grades and credits earned for each course completed
- Course indicators
  - \* = non academic
  - p = college prep
  - + = some Honors and all AP courses bearing “weighted” GPA
  - r = course has been repeated and GPA revised
- GPA
- Total credits attempted and total credits earned
- Community service
- Graduation status

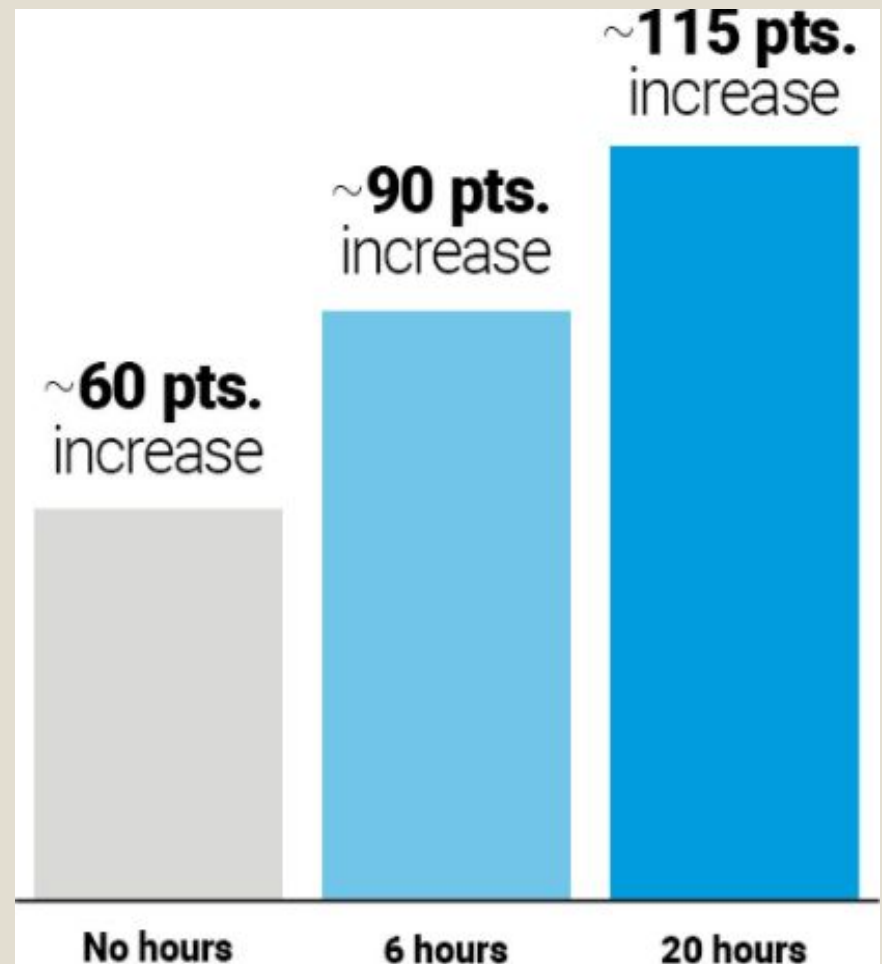

A study of 250,000 students from the class of 2017 showed that a little practice goes a long way—regardless of gender, race, income, or high school GPA. In fact, 20 hours on Khan Academy® was associated with an average 115-point increase from the PSAT/NMSQT to the SAT.

# SUGGESTED TESTING TIMELINE



- **SAT Reasoning Test and ACT**

- Spring semester of Junior year
- Repeat (as needed or desired) Fall of Senior year

*NOTE: SAT and ACT test dates do not conflict with each other*

- **SAT Subject Exams**

- Spring semester of Junior year (exception...after specific subject completion; i.e. AP European History or Pre Calculus or, perhaps, LOTE (Language Other Than English))
- Repeat (as needed or desired) Fall of Senior year

- **AP Exams**

- May of Sophomore, Junior, Senior year

# PREPARATION AND PLANNING



- Research Colleges (consider location, size, majors, etc.)
- Create list of potential colleges with deadlines and requirements
- Develop resume
- Work on college essay prompts or questions over the summer
