HOW DO I ENTER MY MIDDLE SCHOOL A-G COURSES?

The most common classes to indicate from middle school are Math 1 or Enh. Math 1 and first year of World Language (i.e. Spanish 1). You would only indicate classes in middle school that are indicated on our A-G list for Irvine High School.

SPECIAL EXAMPLE: If you attended San Joaquin HS for summer school after 10th grade and then you continued to attend San Joaquin HS for the 11th grade, the UC application will require that you select that you attended 10th grade at San Joaquin HS. **This allows you to select the summer school option.** However, when you input your courses, the UC application will require that you enter a full year of 10th grade classes at San Joaquin HS. **UC Admissions has advised that you ignore the error message** and continue to enter your classes for grades 11 and 12.

Once you get to the end of the Academic History section, you will see a message saying that you did not enter classes for the 10th grade school year. Please verify that your information is correct and **then include a note in the Additional Comments box saying, “I completed summer school at San Joaquin HS in 10th grade.”** **This will allow you to submit the application.**

HOW DO I ADD A COLLEGE CLASS TO MY APPLICATION?

Make sure you enter each college where you have taken a class - online or classroom. Please make sure you enter the correct dates you attended the college.

HOW DO I ADD AN IVC CLASS TO MY APPLICATION?

- 1) Please find the correct department (ex. American Sign Language) to see the list of courses offered at the college (ex. IVC).
- 2) Then select the course you took and the grade you received.
- 3) Report all grades for all academic courses you enrolled in, including withdrawals and incompletes.

To enter your courses and grades, click on a department to see the list of courses offered at the college, and select the courses you took and the grades you received.

If your courses aren't listed, check the box next to "I don't see my courses" at the bottom of the page and enter them manually.

Please report all grades received for all academic courses you enrolled in, including withdrawals, incompletes and courses you may have repeated at a later date. Do not list athletic courses or any non-academic courses which do not satisfy the UC subject area requirements.
