Minimum Graduation Subject Requirements

- 40 Credits English
- 20 Credits Math 1 or Algebra 1
- 20 Credits Science
- 10 Credits World History
- 10 Credits US History
- 10 Credits Political Economy
- 10 Credits Visual/Performing Arts/Career Tech
- 20 Credits Physical Education
- 5 Credits Health
- 70 Credits Electives
- = 215 Credits

Minimum College/Graduation Subject Requirements CSU/UC

- 40 Credits English
- 30 Credits Math (must include Algebra 2 or Math 3)
- 20 Credits Laboratory Science
- 10 Credits World History
- 10 Credits US History
- 10 Credits Political Economy
- 20 Credits LOTE and
- 10 Credits Visual/Performing Art
- 20 Credits Physical Education
- 5 Credits Health
- 40 Credits Electives
- = 215 Credits (150 CP)

- **Official transcripts for international students**
 - Must be received in a **sealed and unopened envelope** directly from **all** schools previously attended.
- Students ***without*** a student ID card or books
 - Report to the library on Thursday, August 24th at 7:00 a.m.
- Students ***with*** an ID card and books
 - Report to Advisement on August 24th at 8:00 a.m.
- Check the IHS website and Parent Portal often
 - Reminder to set up a Parent Portal account!
- And...remember these important dates!
 - Thursday, August 24- First Day (8:00 a.m. – students meet in TA)
 - Wednesday, September 13 – Back-to-School Night

Schedule Questions



- **Schedule Adjustments**

- Emergency Schedule Adjustments are the first two days of school for the following reasons:

- **Two classes scheduled in the same period**
- **Under or Over-enrolled**
- **Incorrect Level; i.e., Spanish 2 instead of Spanish 1**
- **Course Completed**
- **Seniors Only - missing a class needed to graduate (See your own counselor)**
- **Missing required core course; i.e., US History for juniors**
