GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

9th Grade

✓ Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better

10th & 11th Grade

- ✓ Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better
- ✓ Grades from 10th and 11th grades are used to determine eligibility.

12th Grade

- ✓ Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better
- ✓ Grades from 10th, 11th, & 12th grade are used to <u>maintain eligibility</u>

CSU will award up to 8 points of AP/IB/Honors credit

Grades of D or F earned in AP/IB/Honors courses are not given an extra point
