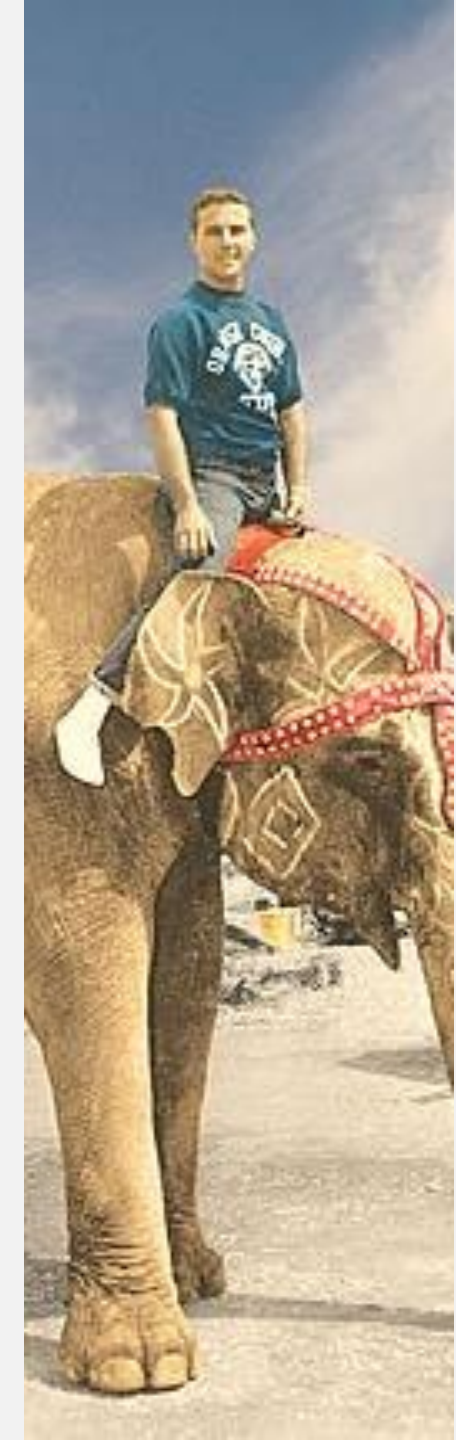

- ✓ A-G Requirements with a C- or better
- ✓ Take SAT/ACT tests
- ✓ Meet CSUF Eligibility Index Cut-offs
- ✓ Meet All Deadlines



FIRST TIME FRESHMAN STUDENTS

A-G REQUIREMENTS

A. History/Social Science	2 years
B. English	4 years
C. Math	3 years
D. Laboratory Science	2 years
E. Language other than English	2 years
F. Visual/Performing Arts	1 year
G. College-Preparatory Elective	1 year



FIRST TIME FRESHMAN STUDENTS

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

9th Grade

- ✓ Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better

10th & 11th Grade

- ✓ Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better
- ✓ Grades from 10th and 11th grades are used to determine eligibility

12th Grade

- ✓ Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better
- ✓ Grades from 10th, 11th, & 12th grade are used to maintain eligibility

CSU will award up to 8 points of AP/IB/Honors credit

Grades of D or F earned in AP/IB/Honors courses are not given an extra point

Local area **transfer applicants** come from community colleges in Orange County.
